

Stony Creek Ravine Nature Park Closed Tuesdays & Wednesdays

Controlled Archery Antlerless Deer Hunting

October 1st, 2020 - January 31, 2021



Oakland Township purchased Stony Creek Ravine Nature Park in 2008 and 2019 with the majority of our purchase costs being paid by Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund grants. One of the conditions of our receipt of these substantial grants was that we must allow controlled archery deer hunting at this park as part of the DNR's program to manage deer populations in southeast Michigan.

To meet this commitment, a limited number of hunters per hunt date will be issued Township permits for antlerless archery deer hunting at Stony Creek Ravine Nature Park on restricted weekdays between October 1, 2020 and January 31, 2021. **ON THE DAYS WHEN HUNTING WILL OCCUR THE PARK WILL BE CLOSED TO OTHER TYPES OF USE.** Signs are posted at park entry points indicating these days of closure.
