Please mark up the enclosed Strategy Plan map with your suggestions and complete the survey on the last page and leave it with us when you leave.

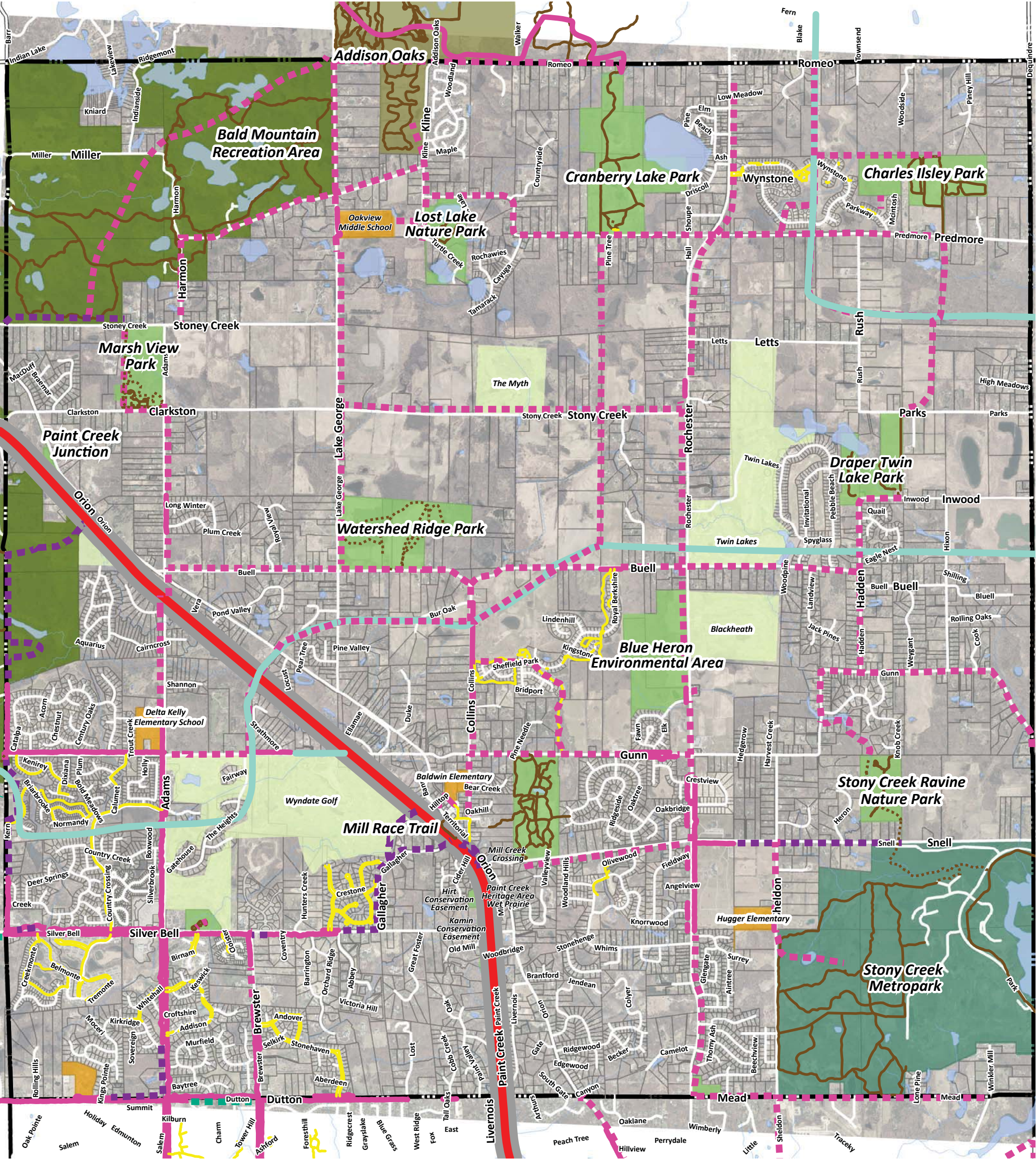

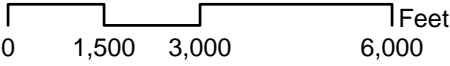
