NOTICE OF PROJECT PLANNING DOCUMENT PUBLIC MEETING

FY2024 DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (DWSRF) PROJECT

The Charter Township of Oakland will hold a public meeting on the proposed water storage facility and booster pumping station for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The meeting will be part of the regular Township meeting at 7:00 p.m. on May 23, 2023 at 4393 Collins Road, Rochester Michigan 48306.

The purpose of the proposed project is to provide water storage as required by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) for water supplies serving greater than 150 service connections. This project is necessary to ensure that the Southwest Water System can maintain water pressure to residents and provide stored water in the event of an emergency.

The project construction will include a 1.0-million-gallon drinking water storage tank and booster station.

Impacts of the proposed project include normal activities related to construction, including increased traffic, excavation activities, and limited noise.

The estimated Total Capital Investment is \$15,300,000 with \$3,000,000 having already been collected by the Township. The DWSRF funds requested are \$12,300,000. There are approximately 2,003 users and the estimated cost to the users will be \$403.30 per year.
